By AIR:

Dothan Regional Airport (DHN) is 20 miles away and is served by Delta.

Montgomery Airport (MGM) is 82 miles away and is served by many major commercial airlines.

Panama City International Airport (ECP) is 90 miles away and is served by many major commercial airlines.

Ozark (Blackwell) Airport (71J) is 6 miles away if flying your private airplane.

Simply use your GPS! Put in: 1231 County Road 59 North, Ozark, AL and it will take you to the Hidden Springs Airpark sign at the entrance. Feel free to drive around and look at all the airpark has to offer.

HIDDEN SPRINGS AIRPARK

Located in Ozark, AL (36AL), Hidden Springs Airpark is a private fly-in community, situated in the South-East corner of the state, between Dothan and Montgomery. It was developed on 92 acres of farmland and is comprised of 20 lots each being 3+ acres and a 3,000 foot grass runway. It is in Dale County and just 5 miles outside the city limits of Ozark; a country setting, yet close enough to city amenities.

This country setting offers peace and quiet, as well as a variety of wildlife inhabitants, including deer and turkeys. The paved roads are used as taxi ways so each lot can access the runway. It also makes an excellent walking path. Underground electricity and underground telephone lines are in place and ready for hook-up. Hidden Springs Airpark is conveniently located for access to many other locations. It is 2 hours away from the beaches at Panama City, FL, 1 hour from Lake Eufaula, 1.5 hours from Montgomery, and just 20 miles from either Dothan or Fort Rucker. Ozark is one of America's best small communities but can easily enjoy all

of the offerings of larger towns, water skiing, camping, fishing, golf, beaches, shopping, restaurants, theaters, musicals and festivals.
